


## The 49th International Aircraft Parts Fair at the Technik Museum Speyer The traditional event for aviation fans is back

Speyer. Where are historical aircraft parts still offered today? Many aircraft enthusiasts across Europe know the answer: The answer to this is quite simple, because at the 49th International Aircraft Parts Fair, you get everything a collector's heart desires. The event will be held in the immediate vicinity of Speyer Airport, in Hangar 10 of the Technik Museum Speyer, and will open its doors on Saturday, 15th April 2023, from 8 am to 5 pm. Tickets are available at the ticket office for 7 euros, children up to the age of 14 get free entry. Numerous exhibitors from Germany and abroad will be presenting their rare aircraft parts on this day, which they will sell, exchange or simply talk about. Visitors will see instruments and propellers from the 1stWorld War, jet helmets from the seventies and much more. A large part of the fair will include parts for the so-called warbirds such as the Messerschmitt Me 109 and the Focke Wulf Fw 190. But there will also be books, drawings, photos, and historical clothing on offer.

While the IMAX 3D cinema in Sinsheim – "the cinema with the highest resolution in the world" – shows exclusive documentations and the latest Hollywood blockbusters, films are projected onto a giant dome in the IMAX DOME cinema in Speyer.
