At the Gauge 1 meeting at the Technik Museum Speyer, model building and railway fans go into raptures. Last year, after the Corona break, the Gauge 1 meeting successfully celebrated its comeback in "Hangar 10" of the Technik Museum Speyer with over 1500 visitors. In 2023, fans and interested parties will again have the opportunity to discover new things and exchange ideas about familiar things with like-minded people. The area in the Hangar 10 event hall will be open from 10 am - 6 pm on Saturday, 24th June and from 10 am - 4 pm on Sunday, 25th June. For 30 years, the traditional event was one of the oldest activities of the Technik Museum Sinsheim. As the interest in the meeting grew, there was no longer enough space in the old event rooms. Cancelling or downsizing was not an option for the museum team. Therefore, in 2022, their eyes turned to the sister museum in Speyer. "We thought long and hard about what to do. After all, the Gauge 1 meeting is close to our hearts. Since Speyer is not far away, we decided to change the location. This way, the meeting will remain for our museum fans. The large number of visitors at the first event at the new location showed us that the move was definitely the right decision," explains project manager Holger Baschleben.

The exhibitors and dealers come from all over Europe. Many clubs will be there to demonstrate their spectacular and lovingly crafted Gauge 1 layouts. Visitors can browse to their heart's content at the numerous dealers. Of course, the exchange of ideas with each other is inevitable in the shared hobby and talking shop with old hands or newcomers is also part of the meeting.
