Audi Type 89 Convertible Meeting at the Technik Museum Sinsheim

Sinsheim. At the end of the 1980s, this exclusive four-seater helped to give the slightly dusty "Audi" brand a new image. The "Kabriolet", as it was originally spelled, inspired enthusiasm with its clear design and without an annoying roll bar. This euphoria continues to this day: On Saturday, 24 June, fans and vehicle owners will come together on the grounds of the Technik Museum Sinsheim for the Audi Type 89 Cabrio Treffen. Organised by the interest group "Audi Cabrio Süd", visitors will have the opportunity to experience these timeless fresh-air gliders live from 9 am to 4 pm. Admission to the event site is free. From May to October, the Technik Museum Sinsheim offers its guests colourful and varied open-air events all about automobiles and motorbikes. It also makes its grounds available to clubs, interest groups and associations. At the end of June, for example, "Audi Cabrio Süd" will be holding its sixth Audi Type 89 Convertible Meeting on the museum grounds, surrounded by technical witnesses to aviation history. The club's reach extends across the whole of Baden-Württemberg and neighbouring parts of Bavaria, Rhineland-Palatinate and Hesse - but friends from the Netherlands, France and Luxembourg are also expected.

On 24 June, numerous colourful classics will line up and revive the 90s on the museum grounds. The organisers are looking forward to welcoming every vehicle: from "barn finds" to original condition to extreme conversions - visitors can look forward to a great variety of young and oldtimers. As at previous meetings, the carefully maintained convertibles will attract the attention of the visitors this year as well. Equipped with folding chairs and car paint polish, the owners will enjoy their vehicles and answer questions about their Ingolstadters from interested visitors. In addition, the volunteer experts help out with questions about engines, electrics, hi-fi

installations, car care, etc. A "dent doctor" will also have plenty to "heal" this year. A valuer will assess the vehicles and since something is always needed, there will be a spare parts sale on the museum grounds.

Besides the permanent exhibition and the changing special exhibitions, there are numerous vehicle and club meetings as well as events. Open 365 days a year, the museums attract over one million visitors a year. Our two IMAX large-format cinemas are a true highlight. While the IMAX 3D cinema in Sinsheim – “the cinema with the highest resolution in the world” – shows exclusive documentations and the latest Hollywood blockbusters, films are projected onto a giant dome in the IMAX DOME cinema in Speyer.
