**Speyer.** In May, the Technik Museum Speyer was able to announce a new attendance record at BRAZZELTAG. More than 20,000 technology fans of engines, horsepower and spectacle attended when a helicopter landed and took off live for the first time during the event. Advance ticket sales for next year's event will start at the end of 2023. As always, BRAZZELTAG will take place on the second weekend in May, on 11 and 12 May 2024. Advance sales start on 8th December 2023.

At BRAZZELTAG, the entire museum grounds are transformed into a huge stage for a unique display of vehicles, a wide range of participation program, aircraft demonstrations and stunt shows that amaze young and old alike. The two-day event leaves nothing to be desired and offers Brazzel enthusiasts new highlights year after year. The term "brazzeln" comes from the inimitable rattling of the engines, which will be heard again in 2024. It is already certain that the experimental vehicle and museum mascot "Brutus" with its 750 hp will of course be there again.
