Sinsheim. On 7th and 8th September 2019, the events space and museum hall at Technik Museum Sinsheim will become a construction zone for the 24th time as fans of miniature construction machine models take over. This popular meeting welcomes all fans of miniature construction equipment: there's always plenty to see and be amazed at.

The focus is on construction equipment, cranes and heavy transports in model size. Great emphasis is placed on details and creating fully functional models, which guests will be able to watch in action live. Over 70 exhibitors will show an interesting cross-section of these types of models.

Outside of the hall, as always, the original equipment and original trucks and cranes show visitors the gigantic proportions of the models shown inside. Such miniature vehicles can't often be purchased as finished kits in toy stores and so these models are a real work of love. Machines from many well-known companies and even entire offshore installations will be here in a miniature version, although some of these "miniatures" are actually quite massive. Remote-controlled trucks and diggers will be in the hall digging around a sand pit: guaranteed fun for fans young and old. Fans and collectors will not only have the chance to watch the action, but they can also acquire a few rare and delicate models for their own collections.

The Mini-Bauma Modell Scale Meeting will take place on Saturday, 7th September 2019 from 9 am till 7pm and Sunday, 8th September 2018 from 9am till 5pm, in the events hall Technik Museum Sinsheim.

Entrance: Adults €4 / Children: €2. Visitors to the museum can present their ticket for the day for free admission to this event.

Owned by the non-profit Auto-Technik-Museum e.V., the Sinsheim-Speyer museums of technology have around 3,000 members worldwide. They are financed exclusively through the admission fees, donations, and membership fees of club members. All surpluses are used to preserve the pieces and to expand the museums.
