For the rally of French classics on April 29, museum makers expect countless classic cars built in the Grande Nation.

Sinsheim. Citroën, Bugatti, Renault - on Saturday, April 29, the Technik Museum Sinsheim invites visitors to a rally of French classics on its grounds. From 9 a.m. to 6 p.m., visitors and participants of the open-market meeting can look forward to numerous rarities built up to 1983. In addition to the opening of the special exhibition "One Hundred Years of the 24h of Le Mans", this gathering will ring in the French Year at the Technik Museum Sinsheim. The Technik Museum Sinsheim opens its new special exhibition on April 1, and in the summer it celebrates its super bird. After all, the museum association brought the Concorde to Sinsheim exactly 20 years ago. In addition to some small events around the French year, the cultural institution organizes a classic car meeting. For the rally of French classics, the museum makers expect countless classics built in the Grande Nation. "On this Saturday, our visitors can experience live that France's technical history has even more to offer than sleek airplanes and nippy bolides," organizer Simon Orth is convinced. Below the contemporary witnesses of aviation history, drivers will be arriving from all points of the compass. Oldtimer enthusiasts can photograph the French motorized rarities and exchange with the owners. On this day, a visit to the newly opened special exhibition "One Hundred Years of the 24h of Le Mans" is especially recommended, as Le Mans expert and curator Uli Ehret as well as two other museum guides will answer the questions from 1 to 5 pm.of all those interested in the spectacular event on the Sarthe. A suitable culinary offer rounds off the event on the open-air grounds of the Technik Museum Sinsheim.

Participation in the meeting is subject to pre-registration and costs Euro 17,-, young adults up

to 25 can already participate in the meeting for Euro 5,-. The registration fee is also an entrance

ticket for the Technik Museen Sinsheim Speyer (Förderverein members are free). This does not

necessarily have to be redeemed on the day of the event. Access to the museum area is free

for visitors.
